CRITERIA FOR BELL COUNTY MASTER GARDENER PROJECT

Master Gardener project should always reflect the educational missions of the Master Gardener Program and the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service. This is not a free labor program. Master Gardener Volunteers are educators, advisors, and helpers.

- **Provide educational opportunities for Master Gardeners and the public**
- **Sanctioned Beautification projects for Churches and schools are not always recommended. Education may be offered while helping organizations in such projects.**
- **Create visibility for Master Gardeners (identified with Master Gardener Sign)**
- **Be accessible to the public without admission fee.**
- **A project should benefit a City, County, State or Nonprofit organization.**
- **Submitted on a Volunteer Project Request form.**
- **Each new proposal must be submitted for Board review at least one month prior to starting date.**
- **After Board review, the proposal will be submitted to the County Agent. The final decision will be made by the County Agent.**
