

Strawberry Shrub

Euonymus americanus



Is there a prettier color combination than the pods and capsules of the Strawberry Shrub? This unique native, understory shrub can be found in the fertile woodlands and along streams of East Texas. It has an upright, irregular, airy form with thin green horizontal stems. Famous for its strawberry-like **hot-pink to red capsules** in the fall that crack open exposing **bright orange seed**. It also has gorgeous red fall color. Shade, filtered light, morning sun. Moist, fertile, well-drained soils. 5'x 4'. Seeds are eaten by songbirds & wild turkey. The plant is a favorite of deer.
