

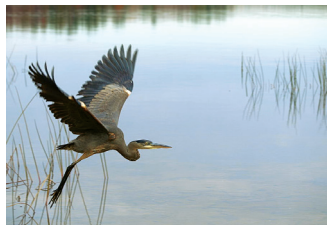
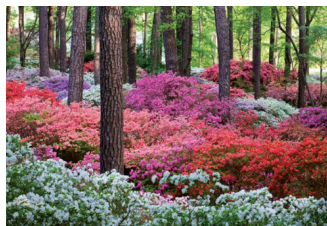
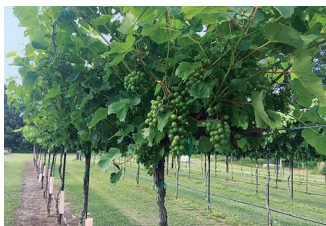


San Jacinto County Master Gardeners
